- Presenting authors must be registered participants and attend the NORA 2024 meeting.
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for publication of the abstract in all printed material of the meeting, including electronic communications.
- Abstracts will be published in Optometry and Visual Performance (even years) or Vision Development and Rehabilitation (odd years). A final electronic version of your poster or paper (PDF preferred) must be submitted to kadamsod@gmail.com for publication by August 31, 2024.
- Abstracts must be original and must not have been published or presented at any other meeting prior to the NORA 2024 Meeting.
- Abstracts must be submitted in English.
- Conflicts of Interest / Disclosure: Work submitted for presentation must include an acknowledgment of funding sources of commercial nature and/or consulting or holding of significant equity in a company that could be affected by the results of the study.
- All studies must have been approved by institutional committees on ethics of experimental and human investigations.

ABSTRACT FORMAT

Abstracts not submitted in proper format will be rejected

- 1. Author and co-authors' details.
 - P Full first and family name(s).
 - Authors' names must be in upper and lower case (e.g., J.J.C. Smith).
 - Affiliation details: department, institution / hospital, city, state (if relevant), country
- 2. Abstract title limited to 20 words.
- Abstract text limited to 350 words, including acknowledgements.
- Abstracts of research projects should clearly state:
 - Background and aims
 - ° Methods
 - o Results
 - o Conclusions
- 5. Abstracts of case reports should clearly state:
 - ° Patient's symptoms
 - Findings, diagnosis
 - Treatments
 - Outcomes
- 6. Abstracts of diagnostic or therapeutic techniques should clearly describe:
 - The procedure
 - o Its applications
 - o Its unique or innovative characteristics.
- Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word appears the first time.
- 8. Use generic names of drugs. Express numbers as numerals.

ABSTRACT SELECTION AND PRESENTATION

- Each abstract will be reviewed for the following elements: (1) scientific and clinical quality; (2) broad appeal to the interests of the membership; (3) multidisciplinary nature; (4) timeliness of the topic.
- Each complete submission received by June 15, 2024 will be independently peer-reviewed and rated on a blind evaluation basis.
- 3. All abstracts will be reviewed by the Posters and Papers Committee. Presenting authors will be notified by July 15, 2024 regarding the status of their abstract. Final posters due no later than August 31, 2024.
